## **SUNY Cortland Wrestling**

### SUNY Cortland vs. Ithaca College

Wednesday, February 7, 2007; Corey Gymnasium; Cortland, N.Y.

### FINAL SCORE: Cortland 23, Ithaca 11

CORTLAND, N.Y. – The nationally ninth-ranked Cortland wrestling team won 7-of-10 bouts and defeated 14th-ranked Ithaca, 23-11, Wednesday night at Corey Gymnasium. The Red Dragons improved to 16-3 in dual matches with the victory, while the Bombers fell to 9-3.

Cortland opened up a 6-0 lead as nationally seventh-ranked junior **Phil Archer (Shirley/William Floyd)** won a 4-0 decision at 197 pounds and senior **Matt Eldredge (Canandaigua/Marcus Whitman)** earned a 3-2 win at heavyweight. Ithaca grabbed an 8-6 lead, however, by winning the next two bouts. Freshman **Jon Gregory (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg)** recorded a 20-1 technical fall at 125 pounds, while freshman **Justin Seifried (Herkimer/Mohawk)** earned a 4-2 decision at 133 pounds.

Cortland regained the lead, 13-8, with sophomore **Paul LeBlanc (Morrisville/Morrisville-Eaton)**, ranked third nationally, registering an 11-2 major decision at 141 pounds and senior **John Franchi (Elmira Heights/Thomas A. Edison)** getting a takedown early in overtime to secure a 6-4 win at 149 pounds.

Ithaca pulled to within 13-11 on sophomore **Scott Edwards'** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty) 3-1 overtime win at 157 pounds. The Red Dragons, however, closed out the match with three wins to seal the victory. At 165 pounds, junior **Zack Bogardus** (Fulton/G. Ray Bodley), ranked sixth, worked for a 5-3 decision, and sophomore **Treavor LeBlanc** (Morrisville-Eaton) clinched the triumph with a 7-1 decision at 174 pounds. The final bout of the evening matched up Ithaca senior **Nick Calandrino** (Emerson, NJ/Emerson), ranked seventh, and Cortland senior **Stef Sair** (Huntington), ranked third, at 184 pounds. Sair earned a 13-0 major decision, which included a nine-point third period.
