

Bonus Points Gives Wrestlings 29-15 Win over Franklin & Marshall

Cambridge, Mass. – The Harvard wrestling won its third straight match Saturday afternoon with a 29-15 win over Franklin & Marshall. The Crimson earned two falls, a technical fall and a forfeit in the victory.

Franklin & Marshall started the dual off with two wins in the first two weight classes, but Harvard rallied with three straight victories by bonus points. No. 16 Max Meltzer started the Crimson run with a fall over Al Gianforti in 5:23. Freshman J.P. O'Connor recorded a technical fall over Steven Gregory, 16-0, at 149. At 157, Bobby Latessa earned the pin over Matt Gittleman in 2:04. Junior Matt Button picked up his second win of the day when he earned a 6-4 decision over Justin Herbert at 165 pounds. F&M put more points on the board at 174 when James Schulz defeated Patrick Ziemnik, 11-6. Fred Rowsey accepted the forfeit at 184 pounds putting the home team up 21-12. <u>Jonathan Butler</u> picked up a 3-2 win at 197 before Nico Somers defeated Harvard's Andrew Knapp by major decision,



Harvard is 5-6 overall, 4-3 in the EIWA and 2-1 in the lvy League. The Crimson hosts Cornell Friday, Feb. 16 at the Malkin Athletic Center. The Ivy League bout is scheduled to start at 7 p.m.
