

Caputo and Butler Lead Crimson In 27-15 Win over Brown

Cambridge, Mass. – The Harvard wrestling team won its second straight match with a 27-15 win over Brown Saturday afternoon at the Malkin Athletic Center. The Crimson won seven straight bouts, including two by bonus points to improve to 4-6 overall and 2-1 in the Ivy League. Brown falls to 2-10 overall.

Brown took a 12-0 lead, earning falls in the first two matches at 125 and 133. But No. 16 <u>Max Meltzer</u> got things going for the Crimson with a 5-4 overtime win over Mark Savino at 141. At 149 pounds, sixth ranked <u>J.P. O'Connor</u> picked up six team points when Bryan Tracy was disqualified for stalling. O'Connor held a 12-1 major decision when the disqualification was called. No. 9 <u>Andrew Flanagan</u> tied the team score at 12 with a 7-1 decision over Thomas Fazio at 157 pounds.



Junior Matt Button put Harvard on top with 4-0 win over Brian Cudden at 165 pounds. Freshman Fred Rowsey added three more points with a 6-1 decision over Chris Musser at 174. No. 15 Louis Caputo earned a 15-0 technical fall in 6:00 over Matt Gevenlinger and junior Jonathan

Butler won his 197 pounds match by a 16-3 major decision.

Brown earned a 10-3 decision at 285 pounds when Zach Zdrada defeated Andrew Knapp.
