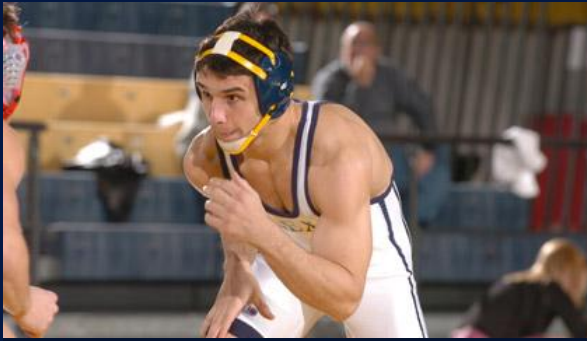


Drexel Wins Final Four Matches to Defeat Brown, 22-14



Senior Mark Cartella spurred Drexel's rally to defeat Brown

Philadelphia - Drexel won the final four matches to lead a comeback victory over Brown in non-conference wrestling action at the Palestra. Down 14-9 to the Bears, senior Mark Cartella defeated Bryan Tracy to start a string of four wins to lead the Dragons to the 22-14 victory. With the victory, Drexel improved to 14-9 on the season.

Down 4-0 after the opening match at 184 pounds, Jon Oplinger pinned Josh Serene at 4:07 to give the Dragons a 6-4 match lead. Brown won three of the next four matches until Cartella spurred the Drexel comeback.

Drexel will finish up its tripleheader at the Palestra with a match against host Penn at 2 pm.
