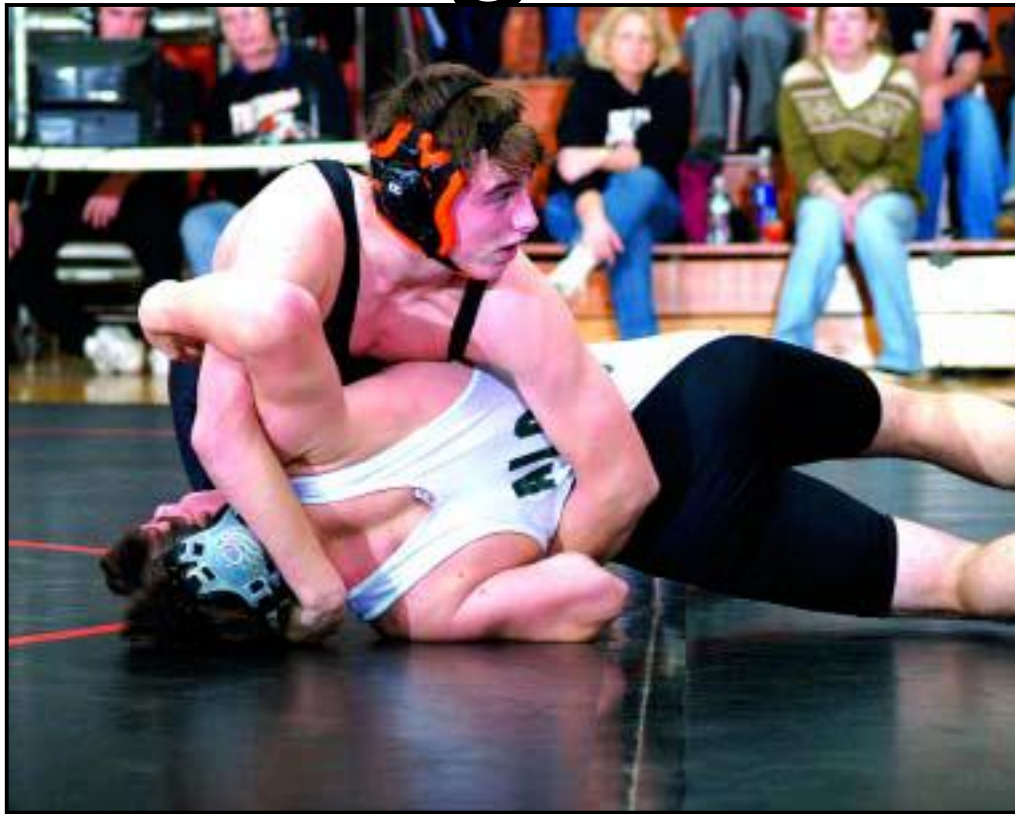


# Taking it to the mats

## *Fredonia's five pins too much for Allegany-Limestone*

The Fredonia High wrestling team recorded five pins as it easily defeated Allegany-Limestone, 74-4, in CCAC Division 1 wrestling in Fredonia.

Alex Lacen recorded the quickest win at 140 pounds, finishing off opponent Robert Hirliman in 41 seconds.

Kenneth Betts (145), Joe Pucciarelli (275), Christopher Conti (119) and Tyler Buckley (125) also won via pinfall for the Hillbillies (8-1).

Betts improved his record to 23-2, including 16 pins, while Conti is 23-3 with 17 pins. Buckley's match was his first as a varsity wrestler.

"Tyler's a freshman," Fredonia coach Alex Conti. "He did a real nice job and made some nice takedowns."

Ben Narraway (135) and Corey King (189) also won matches.

"It was nice to see some young guys step into the lineup and execute things we've been working on in practice," Coach Conti said of Buckley, Narraway and freshman Greg Burroughs.
