Elizabethtown vs. Johns Hopkins Match Notes...

About Elizabethtown...

Elizabethtown most recently traveled to the King's College (Pa.) Tournament Saturday, and there Elizabethtown placed seventh out of 12 teams with a score of 107. In all, 20 Blue Jay wrestlers totaled 42 wins on the day, a higher victory total than that of Elizabethtown's entire 2002-03 season. Four Blue Jays were place-winners at the King's Tournament, including Josh Herbert, who was third at 184 pounds, **Deron Sharp**, who was third at 197 pounds, Eric **Rhoads**, who was fourth at 133 pounds, and Jereme Heisey, who was fourth at 157 pounds. **Herbert** went 4-1 for the day, **Sharp** went 4-1 with a major decision, **Rhoads** went 3-2, and **Heisey** posted a 4-2 record for the day. Although he did not place, **Bud Croswell** went 5-2 with two pins, two technical fall wins, and a major decision at 149 pounds. Pete Achilles went 3-2 at 125 pounds, **Terry Bartholomew** went 2-2 at 133 pounds, and Drew Winegar went 2-2 with a pin at 141 pounds. David Foran went 2-2 with a pin at 157 pounds at King's, and Wayne Hummer went 2-2 at 165 pounds. **Brett Epps** went 2-2 with a major decision at 184 pounds, and Tim Katzaman went 2-2 at heavyweight. Also, Rob Bozart posted a win on a pin at 149 pounds, and Mike Lussier had a win on a major decision at 157 pounds. In the previous week, Elizabethtown opened its season at the Washington & Jefferson College Open November 4. No team scores were kept at that

tournament, and four Elizabethtown wrestlers were place-winners there. Rhoads was fourth at 133 pounds as he went 4-2 with a major decision. Croswell was fourth at 149 pounds with a 3-2 record at Washington & Jefferson. **Epps** was fourth at 174 pounds as he went 3-2 with a major decision. **Katzaman** finished fourth at heavyweight by going 5-2 with three pins on the day. Also, Lussier recorded a victory on a pin at Washington & Jefferson in the 157 pound weight class.

About Johns Hopkins...

Johns Hopkins was to have competed at the McDaniel Green Terror Duals Saturday, but that event was postponed. The Blue Jays were also at one point scheduled to face the U.S. Naval Academy on the road November 7, but that event was cancelled. Prior to that, the Blue Jays opened their season at the Messiah College Open November 4 and placed fifth out of seven teams with 52 points. Tyler **Schmidt** placed second in the 197 pound weight class, as he went 2-1 with a pin. Seeded fifth in the tournament, he upset both the fourth seed and the top seed in his wins. **Marco Priolo** placed third at 141 pounds as he went 2-1 for the day. **Jim Crumlish** won three matches at 157 pounds to take third place. **David Kraus** placed third at 174 pounds, and Eric Fishel was third at 184 pounds. Vincent Domestico was the third-place finisher at heavyweight at Messiah. In all, six Blue Jays placed in the top four at Messiah.
