Williamsville, Iroquois Are Mat Choices

Williamsville and Iroquois, champions of the ECIC's Divisions I and II, respectively, loom as the teams to beat in the annual Section VI wrestling championships which open two days of competition at Orchard Park and Falconer tonight.

The Class AAA and AA teams will vie at Orchard Park, while Falconer hosts the Class A and B schools. Both preliminary rounds get underway at 6:30, with semifinals set for 1:30 tomorrow afternoon and the finals at 7:30 tomorrow night.

Williamsville, after winning the Class AA title for the last three seasons, move up to AAA where West Seneca has ruled for two years. Iroquois, Class A champion last winter, has moved up to AA.

The AAA field also includes Frontier, Tonawanda, Kenmore and Amherst. Maryvale, Lake Shore, Lancaster, Medina, Orchard Park, Cleveland Hill and Hamburg complete the AA entries.

Four individual champions return to defend their titles. Lancaster's Bill Miner, who has lost only one match in four years, will defend his 106-pound crown. Dick Dorr of Williamsville, the 130-pound champ a year ago, will be at 141 and Maryvale's Jack Valentic is back to defend his 167-pound title. Iroquois' Dick Krane, who won the 136-pound laurels in last year's Class A-B meet, will put his talents to work in Class AA for the first time.

With Iroquois gone, the Class A-B race is likely to be wide open. Falconer, the 1957 champion, and Gowanda, which finished second last year, may rule the favorites. But Cassadaga Valley, last year's Class B king, and Pine Valley, which moves up after capturing the Class C title in 1958, should provide stiff opposition.

The A-B field is completed by Depew, Alden, Royalton-Hartland, Cattaraugus, Salamanca, Silver Creek, Southwestern, Mayville and Randolph.
