

# 120 Wrestlers Bid for Titles In Sectionals

The high point of Western New York's 1960-61 high school wrestling season will be reached tonight and tomorrow night when the Section VI championships are held at four different sites.

Ten schools and 120 wrestlers will compete in the Class AAA tourney at Tonawanda Senior High School, starting at 6:30.

The exact same times hold true at Maryvale, where nine schools and 108 wrestlers will clash in the Class AA championships.

Six Class A schools will be represented by 72 wrestlers at Salamanca. Only two sessions are slated, at 1 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. tomorrow. Eight schools and 96 wrestlers will make up the Class B field at Silver Creek. First-round competition begins at 7 tonight, with tomorrow's sessions at 1 and 7:30.

Williamsville will defend its Class AAA title against Amherst, Cleveland Hill, Frontier, Kenmore East, Kenmore West, Lockport, North Tonawanda, Tonawanda and West Seneca.

## Billies Favored

The Billies, ECIC Division I champions, will be favored to repeat. They boast four defending AAA champions — John McKeever, 106; Dan Brown, 115; Doug Miller, 141; and Mike Donohoe, 157. Only other returning champion is Amherst's Bob Jackson at 120 pounds.

Iroquois will be favored to take home its third straight Class AA title. The Chiefs, victorious in 67 straight dual meets and ECIC Division II kings, have four individuals who will seek to repeat as Sectional champions—Ron Zielinski, 141; John Schroeder, 157; Bob Balcerzak, 183; and Jeff Bennett, heavy-weight.

Other schools in the Class AA tourney will be Hamburg, Lake Shore, Lancaster, Maryvale, Medina, Niagara-Wheatfield, Orchard Park and Springville.

Gowanda will seek its third consecutive Class A crown, with competition being afforded by Depew, Eden, Falconer, Salamanca and Southwestern.

Casadaga Valley, Class B champion for the last two years, will be opposed by Alden, Cattaraugus, Franklinville, Holland, Pine Valley, Randolph and Silver Creek.
