# Section VI Mat Event Set Today

North Tonawanda and Iroquois boast the largest number of top-seeded entrants in the Class AAA and AA Section VI wrestling tournaments which open at 5 this afternoon at West Seneca and Iroquois high schools.

NT grapplers are top-seeded in the four lightest weight classes in the AAA event at West Seneca. They are: Jim Campbell (98 pounds), Dave Ruzylko (106), Gord Caughill (115) and Al Costanzo (123).

Amherst, the unbeaten ECIC Division I champion, has three favored wrestlers in Henry Gullia (130), John Parkinson (157) and Nick Kish (183).

North Tonawanda is the defending champion.

The three Rudich brothers—Ray, Rod and Ron—head a list of seven Iroquois wrestlers who are top-seeded in the Class AA tourney at Iroquois.

Ray competes in the 98-pound class, while Rod is a 106-pounder and Ron is at the 130-pound level.

Other favored representatives of the unbeaten ECIC Division III champion Chiefs are: Russ Brookman (123), Bill Reinard (148), Warren Wheeler (157) and Todd DuMoulin (183).

## Tourneys End Saturday

Both classes will conclude their tournaments Saturday, with the semifinals slated for 1 p.m. and the final at 7 p.m.

Class A teams will compete at Gowanda on Saturday only at 1 and 7 p.m. The B and C tourneys will be held at Silver Creek with the same schedule as the A event.
