

# Iroquois Takes Four Wrestling Tourney Titles

Iroquois and Amherst, with a combined total of seven champions, Saturday night dominated the Erie County Interscholastic Conference's second annual invitational wrestling tournament held at Amherst Central.

Iroquois' winners were John Penzes, 98 pounds; Clark Reinard, 130; Ken Ellison, 141, and Carl Schroeder, 157. Amherst's champions were Henry Gullia, 123; his brother John, 136, and Nick Kish, 168.

Other champions crowned were Williamsville's Paul Crapsi at 148 and heavyweight John Troglauer; Hamburg's Jim Alexander, 106; Frontier's John Tyran, 183, and West Seneca's Dwight Beranek, 115.

Beranek, Henry Gullia, Kish and Tyran also won in the 1962 meet. Ellison edged John Gullia for the tournament's "outstanding wrestler" award.
