

# Maryvale Leading Sectional Tourney In AAA Wrestling

The semifinals of the Section VI Triple-A wrestling tourney started at 1:30 p.m. today and the finals will move at 7:30 in the North Tonawanda High gym.

Maryvale has 23 points to lead the parade of 14 teams with Amherst next on 20, followed by Frontier, Kenmore East and Williamsville with 19 each. Tonawanda has 17 point., entering the semis with North Tonawanda and Kenmore West having 13, Niagara Falls 12, Jamestown 7, West Seneca 6 and 3 each for Lockport and Hamburg with 2 for LaSalle.

Two points are given for a pin and one for a decision.
