# Niagara-Wheatfield Wins Mat Tourney

**SANBORN**—Niagara-Wheatfield Central School won its first Section VI, Class AA wrestling tournament championship Saturday night with 114 points to dethrone Iroquois, the perennial Double A champion.

Iroquois was second with 98 points as the school took a national record of 143 dual match victories into the annual sectional tourney, a two-day affair held in the N-W gym.

Niagara-Wheatfield, the unbeaten Niagara Frontier League champion for the third straight season, has an impressive string of 48 dual match triumphs.

### N-W Wins 6 Titles

Niagara-Wheatfield wrestlers won six individual titles, Bob Stokes at 106 pounds, Richard Carlson at 115, Bill Stokes at 123, Jim Ellerington at 141, Fred Bauer at 148 and John Bradt, heavyweight.

The Stokes brothers and Ellerington are unbeaten this season.

Carlson was named the tourney's most outstanding wrestler. He pinned Rod Rudick of Iroquois in one minute, 54 seconds of the 115-pound final.

Runnerup Iroquois won two individual titles—Bill Bierl at 168 pounds and Mike Abt at 183.
