# Sheldon, Case, Jones win Section 5 mat crowns ★

Victor's Penn Sheldon won his fourth straight Section 5 class B championship while Gerry Case and Don Jones of Canandaigua won Section 5 titles in Class A, Saturday.

These three, along with other Class A and Class B champions move now to the Class A-B meet tomorrow night at Hobart College's Bristol gym, with the winners there moving on to the Intersectional tournament at RIT, Friday and Saturday.

Case advanced in the 95 pound class when he decided Steve Hall of Mynderse in overtime, 2-0.

Jones won by scoring a 7-5 decision over Keith Stergion of Corning East in the 138 pound final.

Sheldon, a senior, who has won a Section 5 Class B title every year since he was a freshman, scored a 13-5 victory over Greg Thomas of Geneseo in the 145 pound division.

Only two other Class A representatives from the Wayne - Finger Lakes reached the finals. Don Langdon of Canandaigua was beaten, 8-3, by Roger Bubel of Spencerport.

Paul Manslank of Geneva lost an 11-5 decision to Rick Zweig of Irondequoit in the heavyweight final.

Only one other area wrestler reached the finals in Class B.

Tom Brown of Trumansburg was pinned in 3:59 by Bill Wilcox of Warsaw in the unlimited final.

Elsewhere in the Class A tournament held at Corning Community College, Dave Hall of Mynderse finished third and Bob Connelly of Canandaigua sixth in the 103 pound class.

Al Calabro of Mynderse was fifth while Gary Gustin of Canandaigua was beaten twice in the 112 pound class.

At 120, Jim Sinicropi of Mynderse lost his first two matches.

At 127 pounds, Tom Pearce of Waterloo beat John Miller of Canandaigua again to finish fifth with Miller taking sixth.

Dan Moak of Wayne finished fifth in the 133 pound division.

Both Jim Lashbrook of Mynderse and Paul Simmons of Penn Yan failed to win a match at 138 pounds.

John Morrice of Canandaigua finished third while Paul Short of Newark was beaten in both matches in the 145 pound division.

Paul Kronenwetter of Mynderse gained revenge against Tony Calabrese of Geneva in a rematch of the W-FL final, with Kronenwetter taking third and Calabrese fourth at 154 pounds.

Stu Smith of Mynderse was fourth and Dick Atkinson of

Phelps-Clifton was beaten twice in the 165 pound division.

Dave Moreland of Mynderse beat out Al Davis of Wayne for third place in the 175 pound class.

Tom Rother of Canandaigua finished sixth in the heavyweight division while Gary DeKruger of Newark was fourth in the unlimited weight class.

In Class B, Bob Lewis of Watkins Glen pinned Dennis Cody of Victor to take fifth place at 95 pounds.

Bob Garlock of Victor and Bill Birch of Odessa both lost out in the 103 pound division while George Bond of Watkins and Ron Bowerman of Victor did the

same at 112.

At 120 pounds, Ben Babcock of Trumansburg finished fifth while Don Neil of Marion was beaten at 120.

Bob Grath of Victor was fifth at 127 pounds and Jerry Walawander of South Seneca wound up without a win.

Terry Cotton of Victor gained revenge for a loss to Steve Welch of Trumansburg in a battle for fifth place at 133, Cotton winning this time, 6-2.

Miks Skorusa of Dundee finished fifth with Dave DeMistry failing to win at 138.

Rocky Teeter of Odessa lost his first match and defaulted at 145.

At 154, Ron King of Trumansburg took fifth while Gene Cologgi failed to win.

Jim Winkler of Victor beat Jeff Willard of Trumansburg, 5-1, to take fifth place at 165 pounds.

Mike Carver of Trumansburg beat Tom Lauder of Victor for fifth place at 175 pounds and Chris Gellcrest of North Rose beat out Tom Carruthers of Dundee for fifth in the heavyweight class.

Tomorrow night, Case will meet Andy Stano of Caledonia in the 95 pound bout and Jones will take on Bob McMahon of Caledonia for the 133 pound title. Sheldon will go against

Jim Nowak of Eastridge in the 145 pound test.
