

Tonawanda Gains AAA Mat Crown

Tonawanda claimed four individual champions, including the tournament's outstanding wrestler in Brian Beutner, and captured the Section VI Class AAA team title on the Warriors' mat.

The Warriors totaled 91 points, seven more than runner-up Sweet Home, which crowned three champions, and 11 more

than third-place Maryvale, which also had four individual winners.

Beutner snared the 155-pound title by pinning top-seeded and previously unbeaten Greg Hollander of Orchard Park in 4:41. Other Tonawanda winners were Sam Williams, 115; John Debiase, 123, and George Lasky, 165.

Three Repeaters

Three of Maryvale's champions were the tourney's only repeaters from 1969—Gary Brice, 107; Jim Guizzotti, 130, and Doug Leroy, 145. The Flyers' fourth winner was 250-pound Jack Bernard.
