

Six Medina Matmen Favored In Tourney



Medina, champions of the Niagara - Orleans Wrestling League, will have six top-seeded wrestlers in this weekend's Section VI "BBB" Tournament.

The 12-team tourney will be held at Wise Junior High in Medina and the host Mustangs, coached by Bill Ames, are heavy favorites to walk away with the team title.

Preliminary competition and quarter-final action gets under way this evening (5:00 p.m.) with tomorrow's semi-finals at 2 p.m., the consolations at 6:30 p.m. and the finals at 8 p.m.

Teams entered include Akron, Albion, Allegany, Cassadaiga Valley, Depew, Falconer Gowanda, Medina, Roy-Hart, Salamanca, Starpoint and Wilson.

Medina wrestlers ranked at the top of their weight class include Jim Heschke (115), Robin Rott (130), Nathan Knight (145), Bill Ames (155), Charlie Pettit

(175) and Tom Kwiatkowski (215).

Starpoint's Dennis Flack (98) and defending section champ Stew Otto (137) are also top-seeded, as is Wilson's unbeaten Mike Moley at 123.

Winners of this weekend sectionals will go to Erie County Community College next weekend for the Interclass Sections.

The state finals will be held in Syracuse on March 13-14.
