

Medina Wins Mat Laurels

Host Medina crowned five individual champions and walked off with the Section VI Class BBB wrestling title, scoring 107 points to 61 for runner-up Casadaga Valley.

The Medina champions included Jim Heschke, 115; Robin Root, 130; Bill Ames, 155; Charley Pettit, 175; and Tom Kwiatkowski, 215.

Casadaga Valley's Graig Segerlin, the 165-pound titlist, was voted the tournament's outstanding wrestler. Only 1969 champion to repeat was Starpoint's Stew Otto in the 137-pound class.
