

County Grapple Meet Duplicates Loop Finish



Give County wrestling a couple more years and maybe it'll dig up a rival for Gowanda; right now the school that gleans many of its prospects from an Indian reservation is too tough a nut to crack. The Panthers haven't lost in two seasons and Saturday skinned five other schools in the sec-

ond annual County Meet at Southwestern. They did it decisively, capturing six championships to Mayville's three and thrashing runnerup Falconer on points, 94-69. Mayville got 59, Southwestern 57 without a title, Cassadaga Valley 31 and Pine Valley 18. That was exactly the way the

league stood after winding up a 50-meet schedule last Wednesday. The Falks, who took only two individual titles (Cassadaga picked up the last) may have lost another when Arlen Lefford reined up with a re-occurrence of asthma trouble and defaulted his undefeated string.

Mayville's Dick Krause, the eventual 106-pound champ, turned in the quickest pin, a 21-second preliminary flattening. Dave Dake of Falconer pinned his first two opponents in 1:10 but was decided by Bob Graves in the 178-pound final.
