

CAL. WRESTLERS PLACE THIRD IN TOURNEY

Caledonia was a guest of Spencerport in their annual Christmas tournament which took place last Saturday. Caledonia wrestlers placed third in the tournament which was comprised of eight teams. The team results were as follows: first, Spencerport with 111 points; second, Canandaigua, 62 points; third, Caledonia with 50 points; fourth, Madison, 49 points; fifth, Sweet Home, 46 points; sixth, Brighton, 31 points; seventh, Hilton with 25 points and Fairport placed eighth with 21 points.

Caledonia had three winners in the tournament. Jeff Cohen beat Gallagher of Sweet Home, Duhard of Madison and Elliot of Spencerport on his way to the championship in the 130 pound class for Caledonia. Jeff, winning each of his matches easily. Looked strong.

Mike Miller looked outstanding in each of his three matches in the 145 pound class. Mike won his first match against Dewey of Canandaigua by using the spread eagle pin. Mike decided McKinnon of Brighton in his next match. In the finals of the 145 pound class, Mike met Sawicki of Spencerport and defeated him by a decision to win the championship in his weight class.

The most exciting wrestler Caledonia has is Henry Cobb at the 155 pound weight class. Henry won all three of his matches by pins. The crowd was dazzled by his exhibition of contortionism. Henry has shown a great deal of improvement this year in his ability, which was displayed by winning the 155 pound championship.

In the 98 pound class, Snyder of Caledonia won his first match by beating Fisher of Hilton by a decision. In his second match he was pinned by Gustin of Canandaigua. Snyder finished third in the tournament.

Rapone, representing Caledonia in the 107 pound class, was defeated in his first match as was Blaker, a 115 pound class wrestler. Both of them were eliminated from any further activity in the tournament because of their losses.

Greg Buckley pinned Harp of Fairport in the 125 pound class, but was defeated by Wilcox of Madison in his next match. Wilcox won on riding time. The Madison wrestler at that point had only five matches in his school career. Buckley came back in the consolation matches and beat Nusbaum of Brighton and finished third in his class.

In the 115 pound class, Fili lost by a decision in the last period of his first match. Range of Caledonia was also defeated in his first match in the 175 pound class. Daley wrestled in the 185 class and was defeated in his first match.

Sullivan, wrestling in the 215 pound class for Caledonia was another one of the Caledonia
