**Brave grapplers place second —**

# Jones, Morrice cop mat titles in Spencerport Tournament

SPENCERPORT — The Canandaigua Braves placed second behind host Spencerport in the Spencerport Wrestling Tournament Saturday.

Spencerport came up with five champions, gathering a total of 111 points, while the Braves, who had two first place finishers, had 62 points. Caledonia was third with 50 points followed by Madison (49); Sweethome, of Buffalo (46) Brighton (31); Hilton (25) and Fairport (21).

The Braves had four grapplers wrestling in the finals. Bob Gustin

reached the finals in the 98-pound class but lost to Spencerport's Mark Travis, 7-0. In the 107-pound bout, the Brave's Gerry Case lost his first match in two years, bowing to Steve Williams of Spencerport in a close 3-2 decision.

Unbeaten Don Jones continued to win for the Braves when he pulled out a 10-5 decision over Spencerport's Walt Gartland in the 137-pound class.

The other Brave champion was John Morrice, who decisioned Sweethome's Bruce Frederickson in the 165-pound bout, 4-0.

Besides the two first place and two second place finishers, the Braves had three wrestlers placing third and one fourth.

Canandaigua will swing back into Wayne - Finger Lakes league action tomorrow night, traveling to Phelps to tangle with Phelps - Clifton Springs.

## Owners, office for new Buffalo icers

BUFFALO, N.Y. (AP) — Buffalo's new National Hockey League team has owners, a temporary office in a downtown building, and a list of about 700 people who say they want season tickets.

The owners say they can do nothing with the list because the team lacks players, a place to play, a coach and a general manager. The team also doesn't have a name.

"We are listing them according to when they were received," Robert O. Swados, attorney for the owners said Saturday of the ticket requests.

The team says it has done no advertising, but the applications have come throughout western New York and areas of neighboring Canada.

The team was granted an expansion franchise for the 1970-71 season several weeks ago.
