



Won 150 Straight

Unbeaten Iroquois Meets Attica Today

Iroquois wrestling coach Pat Patterson calls this afternoon's (4 p.m.) match with visiting Attica "the toughest one we'll have all season."

On the line will be the Chiefs' national winning streak record for schoolboy mat teams. They have won 150 straight, not losing in 10 years.

Attica, unbeaten at 7-0 has three unbeaten wrestlers as does Iroquois. Ray Southard's athletes won the Medina Christwas Tournament and defeated good mat squads at Arcade and Letchworth.

The 97-pound match will pit two unbeaten boys: Fred Schattner of Iroquois and Attica's John Gerhardt. Mike Abt, last year's 180-pound Section VI champ, and Jim

Kemmerer (147) are Iroquois' other undefeated members.

Attica's are Tim Embt (103), winner of 36 straight and last year's Section V 95-pound king, and Larry Fugle (165).

If Iroquois wins, the national record could be extended to 157 this season.

Lake Shore After 36th Straight

Lake Shore will be after its 36th straight win tonight (7:00) against visiting Eden. Unbeaten Eagles are Tim Murphy and Dave Stepniewski at 95 pounds, Mark Ricci (105), Jack Mayne (114), Jim Smaldino (135) and Ron Bernhard (167).

Bernhard lost by a point to Abt in the sectional final last year. Ricci was second last year at his level and Mayne took third after winning the crown in '65. Eden has not beaten LS in five years. Norm Backus is the LS coach.
