



Red Warriors second in AAA mat action

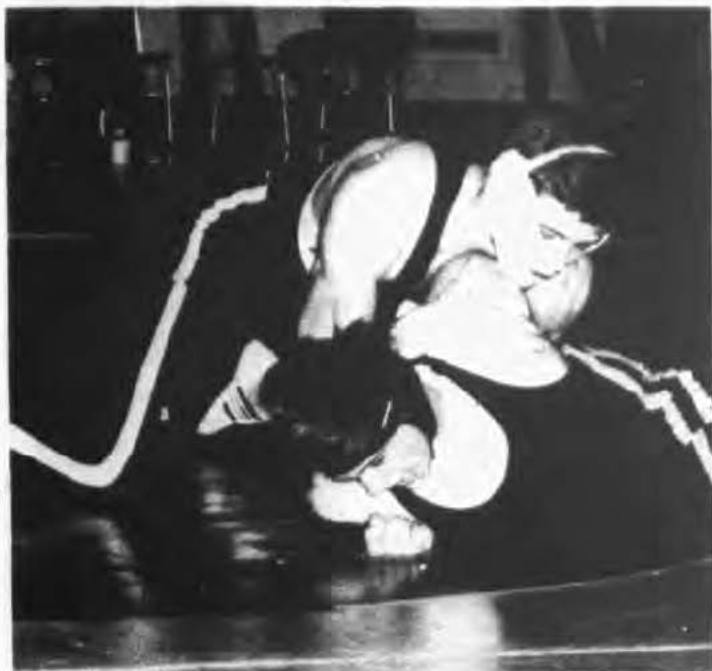
Sweet Home unseated the Tonawanda Red Warriors as Section VI AAA wrestling champion Saturday night by scoring 95 team points to 88 for runner-up THS.

Each team had three champions, but Sweet Home had five second place finishers to four for Tonawanda.

Heading the Red Warriors' effort was Sam Williams who won his second straight sectional title. Williams decisioned Glenn Hettinger of Sweet Home, 7-0, in the 141-pound finals.

Other THS champs were Mike Duncan with a pin over Mike Roncone of Maryvale in the 170-pound finals, and Pete Grumsha who pinned Wes Dust of East Seneca in the 250-pound finals.

Sophomore Steve Leroy, a 122-pounder from Maryvale, was named the meet's outstanding wrestler.
