Tests Start

Section VI public high school wrestling tournaments begin on several fronts tonight with first and second round matches. They finish Saturday.

Niagara-Wheatfield, the unbeaten Niagara Frontier League champion, seeks its third straight Class AA title at Williamsville North.

Nine schools are in the AA meet but the Falcons are the solid favorites. Twelve N-W matmen were seeded, and seven were seeded first. Semifinals are Saturday afternoon followed by the consolations and finals at night.

The Class 4A meet of eight schools will be a one-day affair at North Tonawanda beginning at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, LaSalle Coach Bill Feder said.

Kenmore East is the favorite.

LaSalle was the original site but the Explorers could not host it because of the big junior college basketball game between Niagara CCC and Erie CC there Saturday night.

The Class BBB meet begins tonight at Medina and the Class A meet at Pioneer Central near Arcade. Medina, the unbeaten Niagara-Orleans League champion, is the BBB favorite.
