Medina Captures 3rd Straight BBB Wrestling Crown

FALCONER — Medina captured its third consecutive Class BBB Section VI wrestling crown Saturday night but it took a clutch pin by Dave Brown and some heavy eating by Phil Pettine.

The Mustangs, who are piloted by rookie coach Bill Ossont, finished with 77½ to nip runner-up Falconer, which finished with 74. Salamanca was a distant third with 49 points.

Brown seized the 129-pound championship when he posted a 3-0 overtime victory over Falconer's Bob Sorenson, who entered the bout with a 23-0 record. Brown, a senior, is now 19-3.

Pettine, wrestling in the seldom-used unlimited class, had to eat all week to make the 215-pound minimum. He just tipped the scales at 215 and went on to down Salamanca's John Weir, 7-5, in the finals.

Other Mustangs taking individual honors were Audie Plumley (101) and heavyweight Tom Kwiatkowski. Jim Tierney (108) and Dan Curtin (141) suffered heartbreaking losses in the final round.

Lions Place 6th

Lockport's swimming Lions finished sixth in the nine-team Section VI "AAA" meet held Saturday. Terry O'Malley was fifth in the 200 individual medley; Keith Burhans placed fifth in diving; and Jeff Smith was second in the 100 butterfly.

Falconer sent six boys into the championship round but all six were defeated.

Other title winners from the Niagara - Orleans League included Newfane's Dick Converso (135), Wilson's Steve Pawlak (170) and Akron's John Bradley (180).

Converso decisioned Allegany's Bob Reihle, 9-2; Pawlak blanked Falconer's Dick Johnson, 9-0; and Bradley surprised Falconer's Bruce Johnson, 7-5.

Mike Platt, Newfane's 148-pounder, was decisioned by Ron Parker of Alden. Roy-Hart's 158-pounder, Doug Menzel, also lost by decision in his title bid.

Elsewhere, Starpoint heavyweight Geoff Seal earned a title in the Class A meet.

The winners will compete in the Section VI finals at Pioneer High in Arcade next Saturday.
