

OAKFIELD WRESTLERS WIN COUNTY TITLE

Oaks Get 63 Points to 59 for Alexander, Win Six Matches

Coach George Messinger's Oakfield-Alabama Central School wrestlers shaded Alexander Central in the annual Genesee-Orleans wrestling tournament staged on the Oakfield mats Saturday night.

The Oaks turned in 63 points while Alexander had 59, the State School for the Blind 16, Kendall 11 and Alden 9. Alexander had been favored going into the finals, the A's having had the best record for the year, including a pair of wins over Oakfield.

Oakfield-Alabama wrestlers won six matches and will send that number of men to the sectionals in Rochester on Saturday. Alexander grabbed five first places while the remaining spot went to the State School for the Blind.

Edmond Canne, Batavia sports promoter, presented a cup to Oakfield-Alabama Central for its team victory. Individual medals were given to winners of the first and second places in the tournament.

Fastest win of the night was chalked up by Oakfield's Gerald Scroger in the 133-pound class when he pinned Warren Snyder of Kendall in 47 seconds. William Hagen of Oakfield-Alabama won the 175-pound title by default after James Seward of Alexander Central suffered a broken collarbone in their match.
