Jim Boyer wins championship trophy Section 6 sectionals at Randolph

Randolph Central School's Jim Boyer won the 177-lb. class and championship trophy at the Section 6 BBB-BB Wrestling tournament held in the Randolph high school gym Friday and Saturday.

Boyer decisioned Don Mallery of Portville 13-4 in the finals. He advanced to the championship match by decisioning Pete Wisk of Cattaraugus 18-0 in the first round, pinning Tony Waski of Ripley at the 1:30 mark and decisioning Dana

Linderman 18-4.

He will be going to the State Qualifier next weekend, Friday and Saturday, at Sweet Home. If he wins there, he will compete in the state championships at Rochester.

Boyer's record for the season is 21 wins and one loss, 15 decisions with pins and five superior decisions.

Portville won the sectionals with 80½ points, Franklinville was second with 61½ and Maple Grove third with 60 points.
