

# HOBART WRESTLING TEAM TO MEET "Y" GRAPPLERS TOMORROW

## Orange and Purple Matmen Coached by Ex-College Champ

Bouts Will Afford Local Fans First Opportunity of Witnessing Intercollegiate Type of Wrestling—Deacon Squad Has Several Promising Candidates Seeking Places in Different Weight Classes

Geneva will have its first taste of intercollegiate wrestling tomorrow night when the newly-formed Hobart team will take on the Y. M. C. A. team in an inaugural contest in the Hobart gym.

Although the Hobart matmen lack the experience that the Y. M. C. A. boys have, Coach Joseph Solano, member of the Hobart faculty and former collegiate wrestling champion, has been working hard on the material he has at hand, and tomorrow night's program should feature some interesting bouts.

On the program will be bouts in the 165, 155, 140 and 130

pound classes. Preliminaries will be held at Hobart this afternoon when the team will be chosen from the present squad. Oliver Swift, short, stocky Hobart junior will be Hobart's only representative in the 165 pound class. He has been training for some time and should be able to provide plenty of competition for his opponent. Hobart's strongest class will be the 155 lb., however, there being four eligible candidates for the bout. Twardokus, Baker, Boney and Gammel have all shown up well in practice bouts. Poetter and Chapin are out for the 130 lb. class and Everill and Courage will try for the 140 lb.
