

ATTICA CENTRAL SCHOOL BASKETBALL Holiday Tournament

A Basketball Tournament was held at Attica during the Christmas vacation with Pembroke, Albion, Lyndonville, and Attica participating. In the first game Monday, December 27, Lyndonville defeated Albion 66 to 38. Host Attica downed Pembroke in the other contest, 47 to 42. John Stockholm, Eric Dadd, and Ken McJury were the Devil's high scorers. Tom Middlebrook, Doug Higgins, and John Stockholm led the rebounders with 8 apiece.

Wednesday night, Albion defeated Pembroke 68 to 60, in the consolation for third place honors. In the final, Lyndonville edged out A. C. S. 58 to 54. Dick Gay led all scorers with 23 points and McJury had 14. Attica's top rebounder was Middlebrook with 7.
