

Bellmore And Ithaca Tie For Tournament Honors

Bellmore, L. I., and Ithaca tied for honors of first place, each with a total of 17 points, in the interscholastic high school wrestling meet held at Brewer Field House Friday and Saturday, after a long and tedious battle. Little Falls came in a close second with a score of 16 points, followed by Gouverneur with 15.

The fourteen high schools represented here during the meet were Altona, Bellmore, Canton, Chateaugay, Edwards, Ellenburg, Gouverneur, Ithaca, Little Falls, Norwich, Ogdensburg, Richfield Springs, Van Hornesville, and Watertown.

In the 95 pound class of the tournament bouts, Curcio of Gouverneur took the finals by winning over Vespa of Watertown by a fall in five minutes and 43 seconds. The quickest fall of the finals was taken by Bifora of Little Falls when he threw Bellmore's Schneider in one minute and 55 seconds in the 145 pound class. LaFleur of Watertown was thrown in five minutes, 18 seconds by Albee of Ithaca. These three were the only falls in the final events of the tournament.

Decisions were gained by Hein-
sch. 115 pounder of Ithaca, over Moore of Watertown; Feldmeier, Little Falls, at 125 pounds, over Pelant of Bellmore; Powers, Bellmore, at 135 pounds, over Mount, Ithaca; Frank, Ithaca 155 pounder, over Gros, Van Hornesville; and Sprague, of Gouverneur, over Krutch, of Bellmore, in the unlimited class.

The total scores of the high schools taking part are Ithaca, 17; Bellmore, 17; Little Falls, 16; Gouverneur, 15; Watertown, 7; Van Hornesville, 6; Ellenburg, 3; Ogdensburg, 2; and Edwards 1.
