

SCHOOL BOY

WRESTLERS IN

TOURNAMENT

Canton, Mar. 16—Seventy school boy wrestlers from 12 schools of Northern New York entered the qualifying round of the second annual interscholastic wrestling tournament at St. Lawrence University yesterday afternoon at Brewer Field House. Mark B. Banks, superintendent of the men's dormitory, is in charge of the tourney which will be concluded with the finals at the field house tonight at 7:30 o'clock.

The Norwich team, due to an accident, was unable to arrive Friday afternoon for the first of the two day events but the wrestlers met their opponents from other schools this morning.

But seven matches were held yesterday afternoon. Heaton of Canton wrestling in the 125 lb. class defeated Stouts of Cranberry Lake by a fall in 1.15. Damour of Chateaugay won over Isaac of Wolcott by a referee's decision after wrestling two overtime periods in the 125 lb. class. C. Cunningham of Canton lost to Saluri of Gouverneur High School by a time advantage of 5:31 in the 135 lb. class. Bostner of Little Falls defeated Roy of Alexandria Bay by a time decision of two minutes in the 135 lb. class.

Swayne of Ogdensburg Free Academy defeated E. Lewis of Wolcott by a fall in 3.38 in the 135 lb. class.

In the 145 lb. class Cobey of Alexandria Bay defeated Gilbert of Ogdensburg Free Academy by a time advantage of 1.19.

Livingston of Ogdensburg Free Academy won his match with Glenn Thomas of Canton High in the 155 lb. class by a time advantage of 4.51.

The match between Waltemouth of Little Falls and Zenio of Norwich, 145 lb. class went over until this morning because the Norwich team failed to arrive on time.

In the 95 lb. class there will be no bouts until 2:30 o'clock this afternoon when Church of Canton meets Perkins of Ogdensburg and Seaker of Gouverneur stacks up against Feldmeir of Little Falls.

This morning at 9 o'clock Allen of Alexandria Bay was to meet a Chateaugay opponent in the quarter finals of the 105 lb. class; Hampton of Gouverneur to meet Cooper of Ogdensburg, Kline of Wolcott to meet Ecicler of Little Falls. E. Thomas drew a bye and will meet the winner of the Allen-Higgins bout.

In the 115 lb. class quarter finals today Rotunda of Gouverneur was to meet Haas of Cranberry Lake; Green of Wolcott drew a bye and will meet the winner of the Rotunda-Haas bout; Flint of Van Hornesville will meet Tomia of Little Falls; Lawrence of Canton will meet Smith of Ogdensburg.

In the 125 lb. class quarter finals today Moffett of Potsdam was to meet Heaton of Canton; Collins of Malone to meet Damour of Chateaugay; Smagalski of Van Hornesville was to meet Tyler of Gouverneur and Hella of Little Falls was to meet Snow of Ogdensburg.

Quarter finals in the 135 lb class today included bouts between Axtell of Van Hornesville vs. Saluri of Gouverneur; Hoover of Cranberry Lake vs. V. Lewis of Wolcott; Bostner of Little Falls vs. Burns of Norwich; McCracken of Potsdam vs. Swayne of Ogdensburg.

In the 145 lb. class quarter finals today Cunningham Canton vs. Cobey of Alexandria Bay; Patten of Gouverneur vs. Stark of Malone; Pooler of Van Hornesville vs. Wright of Chateaugay.

In the 155 lb. class quarter finals today Livingston of Ogdensburg was to meet Lee of Norwich; Pistoleri of Gouverneur vs. Provonoril of Little Falls, Sessions of Malone vs. Zande of Cranberry Lake; F. Smagalaksi of Van Hornesville vs. Cramp of Chateaugay.

In the 165 lb. class quarter finals Feldmeir of Little Falls was to meet Stone of Van Hornesville; Sutherland drew a bye and will meet the winner of the Stallone-Burns match.

Arthur of Ogdensburg was to meet the winner of the Mayer of Van Hornesville-Koloski of Little Falls in the quarter finals of the unlimited classes; Ensby of Canton drew a bye and will meet the winner of the A. Cunningham of Malone vs Backus of Gouverneur match.
