## To Participate in Scholastic Meet

### Twelve High Schools to Take Part in Week-end Tournament

Over 100 high school wrestlers are scheduled to compete for honors in the Third Annual Invitation Scholastic Wrestling Tournament to be held here at St. Lawrence this week-end.

At present, twelve high schools are entered in the tournament, which will get under way in Brewer Field House on Friday afternoon. Started in 1933, this event has been increasingly popular among high school coaches and wrestlers, and this year more contestants than ever before have entered.

Contestants will draw for positions Friday at 1:00, and the preliminary round will start on Friday afternoon at 3:30. The quarter-finals are scheduled for Friday evening at 7:30, and in addition the consolation round resulting from the afternoon matches is to be held on mat two.

For Saturday afternoon at 2:00 the semi-finals are scheduled, featuring the winners of Friday's matches. On Saturday night at 7:30 the final and deciding matches will be wrestled. A silver loving cup will be presented to the winning team, and gold medals will be given to the individual winners in the various classes.

There are nine classes in which contestants may compete, ranging from 95 pounds to unlimited, with no 175 pound division. The following teams are scheduled to enter the tournament: Alexandria Bay, Chateaugay, Gouverneur, Little Falls, Malone, Norwich, Ogdensburg, Van Hornesville, Ellenburg, Canton, Coeymans, and Watertown.

Last year Ogdensburg Free Academy was represented by the winning team, and though it has a weaker team than in 1935, it will be out for a second straight victory. It will be given tough opposition by such teams as Little Falls, Van Hornesville, and Watertown.

It will be of interest to St. Lawrence students to know that this season they will be admitted with their passbooks, a system which has not been followed during the past two years.
