New York asking them to send contestants to the third annual inter-scholastic wrestling tournament to be held at the St. Lawrence university here March 14 and 15.

M. B. Banks, superintendent of the men's dormitory, is manager of the tournament, and Roy B. Clogston, university director of athletics and wrestling coach, is director of the tournament. Frank Kavanagh, university trainer, will be official trainer for the high school athletes during their stay in Canton. Robert F. Wellington, post-graduate student, has been named publicity manager, and Ronald T. Burkman, basketball coach, has been designated as financial manager of the tournament.

Competition will be open to wrestlers in the schools mentioned according to eight weight divisions: 105 pounds; 115 pounds; 125 pounds; 135 pounds; 145 pounds; 155 pounds; 165 pounds; and an unlimited weight. Wrestlers will weigh in at the Brewer field house on the morning of Friday, March 13. At that time each contestant will be given a physical examination by Dr. Bruce Smith, college physician. Entry blanks for the tournament must be received by the tournament manager by March 10.
