FILLMORE—Bolivar had the more celebrated wrestlers, including Terry Bentley with 13-3 record, and Brad Konert with a 12-4 mark, but Fillmore had the pins to upset Bolivar 31-25 and share with Bolivar for the championship of the Allegany County wrestling league.

Of the six weight classes in which they won (the 98, 126, 138, 145, 167 and 177), Fillmore grapplers totaled four important pins, which counted for 24 of their points. Bolivar, on the other hand, had only two pins.

Fillmore started out things right when Mike Hale pinned Bill Darling in 2:43. But Bolivar stroked right back, with Matt Dempsey and Rod Hackett picking up pins in the 105 and 112 classes, respectively.

Stan Dunsmore further stretched the Bolivar lead when he decisioned Andy Hale 13-2. Fillmore, not quite out yet, came back with a rally, winning three out of the next four classes. Vic Saylor pinned Mike Petzen at 4:56, Vaughn Saylor decisioned Kevin Sexton 7-5 and Karl Krause pinned Dave Lockwood at 2:44.

Terry Bentley finished out his regular season with a 9-2 decision over Rod Bennett.

After Bolivar's Jeff Johnston won a decision in the 155 class, Fillmore came back to take the lead for good when Ty Wolfer pin Lou Rende at 1:04, and Chuck Manion decisioned Emilio Rende 12-3. Brad Konert of Bolivar won the heavyweight class, but by then, the match was decided.

Cuba 54, Alfred-Almond 15

Cuba evened its record to .500 with the big win over A-A last night, as it worked a deadly combination of pins and forfeits to dump the A-A boys.

Cuba picked up five pins and four forfeits to roll up the score, but Cuba coach Bill Herring was disappointed at the number of forfeits A-A had to give up because of sickness. "It's too bad, because I expected a closer match," he remarked. The last time these two squads met, Cuba, was a narrow 33-29

winner. "The kids were really fired up and came out to win. I guess this gets them in the right frame of mind for the counties."

Two of Cuba's wrestlers, John James and Jim Pastor, went undefeated in league play this season. James was 8-0, and Pastor 7-0.

Alex Cole, who went 22-1 last year, finished this season at a 16-1 mark. Jim Savino, with a 7-1 mark in league wrestling, finished at 12-4.

Franklinville 31, Belmont 25

Belmont got pins out of Kurt Schmidt, Kurwin Pierce and Tim Geffers as it closed out its regular season with a nonleague match against Franklinville.

Ron Strope, the Belmont 180-pounder, revenged an earlier pin to Franklinville's Ed Decker by winning this time 11-10.
