



# City Wrestling Tournament Led by Champion Madison

Madison High School, Inter-scholastic Wrestling League champion, again was the leader through the quarterfinal round of the 20th annual City of Rochester Wrestling Tournament with 17 points last night at East High School.

Trailing the league champions was Edison Tech, last year's tournament title holder, with 10 points. East chalked up 8 points, Franklin 7, Jefferson and Monroe 6 each, Marshall and West 4 apiece and Charlotte 2.

Semifinal, consolation, and final matches are slated tonight at East with a 6 o'clock start. Divisional champs in each of the 13 weight classew will represent Rochester in the Section 5 tourney Feb. 26, at Penn Yan.

Outstanding match yesterday was in the 115-pound class where Edison Tech's Bob Malara was down 3-2 with only 20 seconds left against Jefferson's Larry Barbara. A well-executed reverse hold by Malara pinned Barbara in 5:54.

Fastest pin of the evening was performed by Ray Mondschein of Edison Tech in 26 seconds as he downed his opponent, Mike McLean of Jefferson, in the 148-pound class.

John Turner, Franklin's top grappler, built a margin of 18 points over Dan Kaseman of Monroe, and then went on to a pinning triumph at 3:37 in the 123-pound class.

Two competitors from Madison's unbeaten and untied JV aggregation entered in the varsity tournament defeated opponents who were seeded in second position. Joe Conley defeated Marshall's Stuart Sovatsky by a 3-2 decision in the 115-pound class, while Robert Rosier beat Mike Robinson of West with a 4-1 decision in the 148-pound class.

Both Sovatsky and Robinson were beaten only once during the season before last night.

Defending champions still competing in the tourney are Franklin's John Turner, 115

pounds; Jefferson's Lou Masi, 123; Madison's Robert Perry, 141; Edison Tech's Casper Pizzo, 183; and heavyweight Phil Nucola of Franklin.

The Edward Hulek Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding wrestler-sportsman. Coaches and officials will vote for winner of trophy in honor of the late tournament director and physical education director at Edison Tech.
