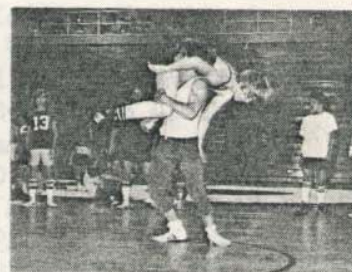

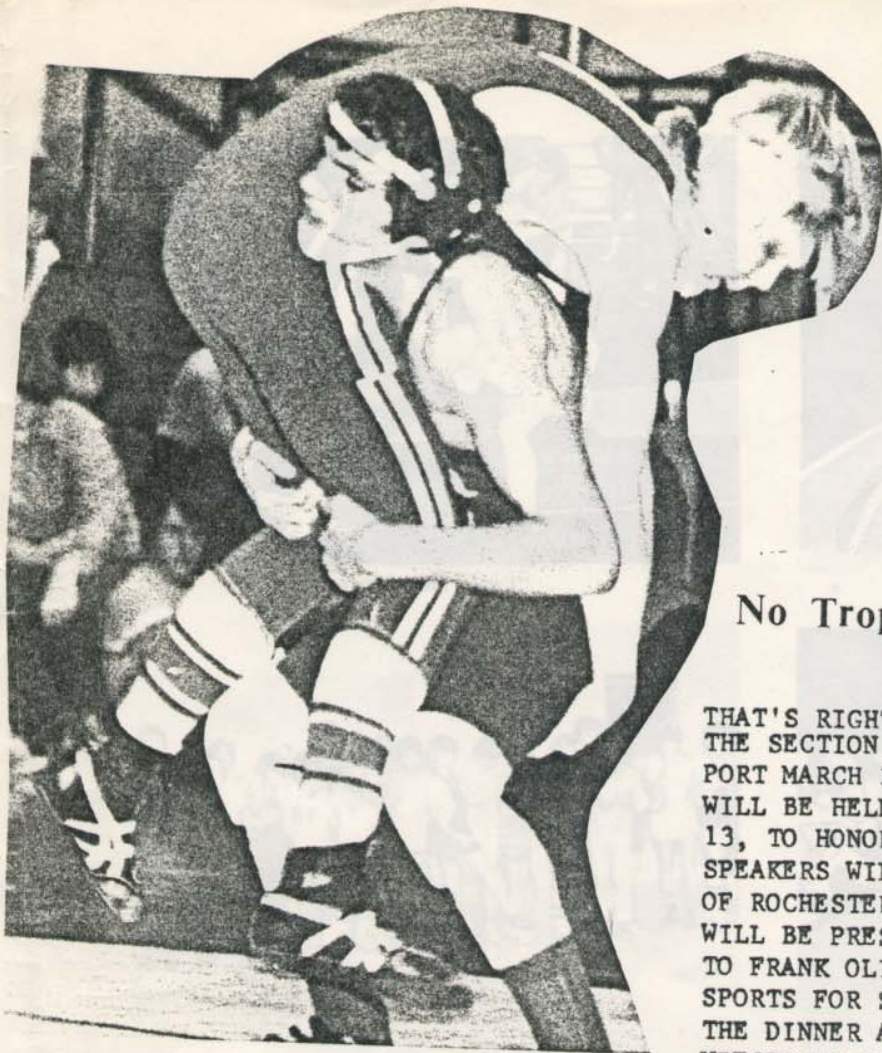

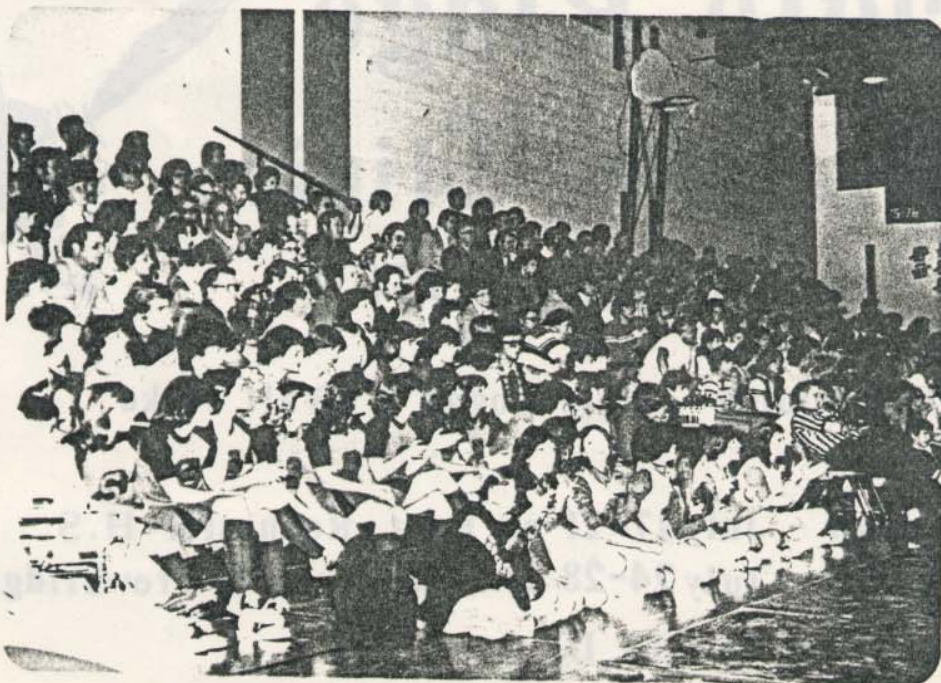






## No Trophy's At Section Finals
