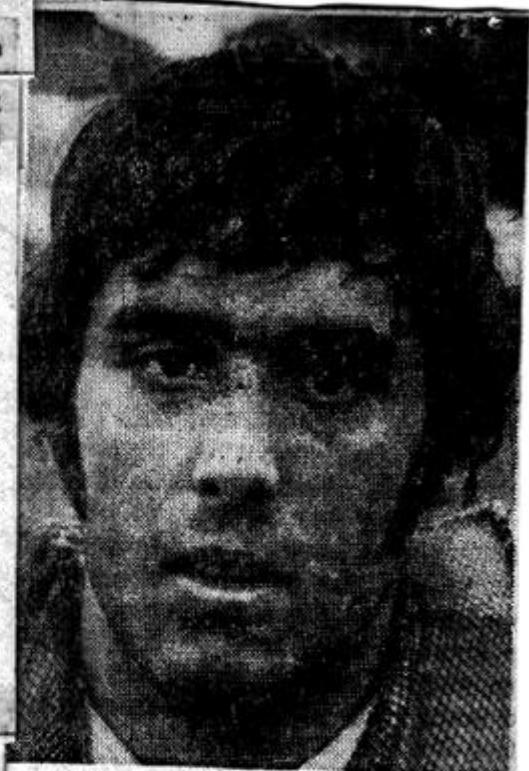

Both teams are unbeaten in the league — the winner meets the County West champ for the league title next Saturday — but if you like comparing scores ER has the edge. The Bombers, who lost to powerful Canandaigua and Olean this season, didn't have the trouble that Fairport had with Sperry and
