# Falconer is early leader

EMPORIUM - While advancing seven wrestlers to the semifinals Falconer (N.Y.) took the early team lead following Wednesday's opening of the Cameron County High School Holiday Wrestling Tournament here.

Rolling up 50½ points, Falconer gained semi-final berths at 98, 126, 138, 145, 167, 185 and heavyweight. Falconer also has the top seeds at 138 in Steve Moore, 167 in Mike Garvey and 185 in Dave Walker.

Following Falconer is defending team champion Ridgway, with 41½ points and six members in the semi-finals.

Third is currently held down by Moshannon Valley, with 381/2 points, led by the brother act of Mark and Matt Dugan.

Mark, a state champion and the top seed at 126 pounds, won his preliminary match Wednesday with a 22-6 decision over Ridgway's Tim Skrabe, before posting a 42-13 decision over Coudersport's Steve Erway in a quarter-final match. He won the 114 pound title last year.

Brother Matt, the number two seed at 132 pounds, used pins to gain today's semi-finals, stopping Duane Button, of Bolivar, N.Y., 33 seconds in the preliminaries, before disposing of Northern Potter's Melvin Miller in the quarter-finals in 29 seconds.

Bradford's Jeff Bean, who won the 100 pound championship last year, this year's top seed at 112 pounds, Doug Austin, the second seed at heavyweight and Ken Lyons, 145 pounds, all advanced to the semi-finals.

Bean, undefeated this season, decisioned Elk Christian's Jim Hackett 3-1 in the preliminaries and pinned St. Marys' Bernie Oreka in the quarter-finals, while Austin drew a first round bye and decisioned Moshannon Valley's Ed Davies 11-3 in the quarterfinals. Lyons, unseeded, pinned third seeded Dave Lockwood, of Bolivar, in the preliminaries and then decisioned St. Marys' Glenn Gever 14-7 in the quarter-finals.

Action will continue today, with the semi-finals getting underway at 1 p.m., followed by the consolations at 6 p.m. and the finals at 7:30 p.m.
