WRESTLING TEAM HAS HARD MATCH WITH SPRINGFIELD

The Alfred wrestlers in a hard match with Springfield college matmen Saturday night at the Old Gymnasium lost $24\frac{1}{2}$ to $4\frac{1}{2}$ after contesting strongly each of the bouts. The Springfield team is rated as one of the best in the East having tied with Cornell University wrestlers, intercollegiate champions, two nights before the Alfred meet. Capt. Caruso of Alfred, 115 pound class, got his man in the first bout with a time decision of 3 minutes and 3 seconds. Cady in the 125 pound class went two extra periods with Johns of Springfield and brought Alfred $1\frac{1}{2}$ points, the decision being a draw. Stearns in the 175 lb. class was handicapped by a bad ear and finally succumbed to Hafner of Springfield on a time decision of 2 minutes and 47 seconds. In the other four bouts Springfield won falls from 6 minutes to almost 9 in the case of Kelly, who despite a sprained thumb on the right hand furnished the most exciting bout of the evening, wriggling out of impossible holds and giving his man a strenuous battle before a fall was called in 8 min. and 50 sec. Kelly was ten lbs. lighter than his opponent.
