

NFL matmen set for sectional meet



Kenmore East High will be host for the Division I Section VI wrestling competition today with eight schools from Western New York part. Division I is made up of the largest schools in the section, according to enrollment.

Preliminary matches begin this morning and continue through the afternoon. Competitions and finals will begin tonight starting at 6 p.m. with eight teams competing.
