



# Scholastic Grappling Makes Debut in Chautauqua County

Scholastic wrestling, an innovation to Chautauqua County, will make its initial appearance Wednesday evening at Cassadaga Valley Central School.

Mayville Central School in the first high school wrestling competition presented hereabouts.

Both schools have been working at the fine arts of the wrestling sport, and Wednesday's meet is of an experi-

mental nature. Wrestling has been discussed, on an inter-scholastic basis, at several recent County Athletic Association meetings, and received a boost when Forbes Brown of the local Y.M.C.A., conducted a clinic for area coaches and students at Mayville Central.

Other schools are favorable to introducing wrestling into their competitive programs, and Wednesday's Cassadaga - Mayville meeting may prove the impetus for inter-scholastic competition in Chautauqua County.

Sponsler Limbaugh of Mayville, instrumental last year in making a move to start amateur wrestling in the County's high schools, is the County chairman.

Limbaugh and Ken Depledge, president of the County Athletic Association and coach at Cassadaga Valley, are hopeful of having 10 matches Wednesday evening. The matches would include weight classes from 85 pounds through 160.

Open to the public, the program is scheduled to begin at 8 P.M.
