Siegfried wins third sectional title*

For the third year in a row Steve Siegfried is a Section 5 Class A wrestling champion. The Mynderse Academy sophomore repeated as 98-pound champion with a 5-1 decision over Wellsville's Mervin Lehman in Saturday's finals at East Rochester High School.

"Steve looked good," said Mynderse Coach Dan Caraher. "He's got as much of a chance as anybody for going to the state tournament."

Siegfried (23-0-3) will be competing in the state qualifier next weekend at Fairport. With Dave Hauf (22-3) at 215 and Bob Plate (12-5) joining Siegfired as champions, Mynderse finished second to East Rochester in the team scoring.

"I was really pleased with the kids," said Caraher. "I never expected a second."

Taking second-places for Mynderse were Dom Caraccilo (14-6) at 138 and Chuck Dove (23-3) at 167.

Buzzy Lamson of Waterloo at 126 and Dave Gastrau of Sodus at 105 were Finger Lakes wrestlers taking second places.

The Finger Lakes West Division provided five champions in the Class B Tournament — Mike Betts of South Seneca at 112, Joe Borrelli of Lyons at 215, Dan Bower of Red Creek at 91, Rich Levan of Marion at 105 and Chuck Metcalf of Bloomfield at 126.

Metcalf (27-2) became Bloomfield's first-ever sectional champion. Chris Maddock of Lyons at 112 was joined as a second-place finisher by Red Creek's Dave Kiemle at 155 and Williamson's Rick Staheli at 105 and leff Staheli at 132.

Host Geneseo won the team title. Defending champion Marion finished fourth, 12 points behind runner-up Kendall.

"I was disappointed in the way we wrestled," said Marion Coach Steve Habecker. "I don't think we could have won it, but we should have had second."

In the Class C Tournament at York, Calvin Switzer of Dundee won the 132 championship. The sixth-place Scots got second-place finishes, from Jim Fultz at 98 and Dave Plumlee at 119.
