

# Braves' wrestlers tune up for showdown ★

The Canandaigua Academy wrestling team, ranked second in the state, tuned up for Saturday's showdown against top-ranked Baldwinsville with two non-league wins on Saturday.

Canandaigua beat Buffalo Sweet Home 37-15 and Olean 39-8 in a four-team match at Canandaigua. East

Rochester, which wrestles Canandaigua on Feb. 19, defeated Olean 35-17 and Sweet Home 23-21.

"The kids did a nice job," said Canandaigua Coach Weldon Canough. "They were fired-up good. Sweet Home's supposed to be the best team in Section 6 and they were ranked 16th in

the state so the kids were mentally ready."

The match that everyone in the crowd was waiting for was between Olean's Clar Anderson, state champ at 112 last year and the wingiest wrestler in state history, and Canandaigua's Matt King at 132. Anderson,

who earlier in the day had decided East Rochester's Romeo Battazzi 6-1, defeated King 5-2.

"It was an all-out brawl," said Canough. "It was probably a battle between two state champs."

Anderson, who will drop down to 126 for the state tournament, and King were tied 2-2 after two periods. At the start of the third period King (19-1) allowed Anderson (22-0) to escape, but King lost a takedown to Anderson.

"Matt lost a couple calls that were on the edge and could have turned the match around," said Canough.

Canough was also impressed with the performance of Mike Reho at 145, who decided Doug Gallon of Sweet Home 6-1 and drew with Rob Parks of Olean 4-4. "Mike wrestled well," said Canough. "He beat one of the best against Sweet Home."

Canough also credited Don Jones at 112, who decided Sweet Home's Tom Wawrzynek 12-0, as playing a key role. "Don fired up the crowd," said the coach. "Sweet Home never got back in the match after his win."

In other non-league matches on Saturday, Newark beat Marion 39-19 and Mynderse beat Lyons 41-12.

Newark's unbeaten Bob Button (21-0) won his 50th consecutive dual match with a pin over Gary DeVries. Mike Block at 132 and Jeff Yost at 138 also scored pins for Newark (6-1 league, 10-2 overall).

Ed Duchesneau at 112 and Jeff Fultz at 155 had pins for Marion (7-0, 11-2).

Mark Golding of Newark decided Tony Titus 9-0 at 145 for Titus first loss of the season.

Dan Dove at 119 and Dom Caraccilo at 132 scored pins for Mynderse (8-4-1 overall). Steve Siegfried (16-0-3) of Mynderse stayed unbeaten with a decision at 98.

Joe Borrelli of Lyons decided Dave Huaf 6-5 at 215.
