



# Five W-FL wrestlers gain shot at state titles

ROCHESTER — Five Wayne-Finger Lakes league wrestlers, four of them Class A grapplers, advanced to the State Tournament Saturday by coming up with Section 5 titles in the Class A-B Meet at the Rochester War Memorial.

The Canandaigua Braves, unbeaten champions of the W-FL Eastern Division, had three champions, while division counterpart, Mynderse had one. Victor, champions of the Class B W-FL Western Division came up with one champion.

Canandaigua's sensational freshman Bob Hadsell captured the 98 pound championship while his brother Bruce copped the 132 pound title. Another Brave, Ron Langdon, came home with the 105 pound crown.

A big surprise was Mynderse's Lynn Chuley, who wrestled his way to the 145 pound championship. Chuley, rated an underdog, decisioned Steve Wark of Gates - Chile, 7-6, in the semi-finals of the Class A meet and then beat Jeff

Freedman of Eastridge, 12-10 in the finals. Chuley decisioned Victor's Brad Ahonen, 10-6, to win the Class A-B crown.

Chuley, who will meet the Section 11 champion in the State Tourney, which will be held Friday and Saturday at the Syracuse War Memorial, used his power moves to great advantage in all of his matches, piling up near-fall points that his opponents could not overcome.

Canandaigua's Steve Schrader, who was expected to fare better in the tourney, because he had beaten Chuley twice this season, lost to Freedman in the semi-finals but took third place by posting a 4-2 decision over Wark.

Victor's lone champion was 117 pound Mike Guinan, who decisioned Webster's Bob Menz in the A-B final.

Bob Hadsell, the only freshman to win a title, became Class A champion by decisioning Clark Barnard of Hilton, 7-0 in the semi-final and by pinning Lou Brongo of Spencerport in the finals. He then decisioned Denny Verkest, class B champ from North Rose-Wolcott, 15-0, to earn his State tournament berth.

Going into the championship match, both Hadsell and Verkest were unbeaten with 22-0 records. Hadsell will meet the Section 6 vs. Section 8 winner in the state tourney.

Bruce Hadsell won his A-B title by taking just 35 seconds to pin Tom Eastwood of Avon. Hadsell had captured the Class A title by decisioning John Gringer of Spencerport, 12-0 and Pete Kundin of Irondequoit, 13-2. Bruce will meet the Section 8 champion in the state meet.

Langdon, who will take on the Section 1 champ in the state tourney, took the Class A title by posting a 16-5 decision over Kelvin Fairwell of East High and a 16-0 decision over Dave Stulpin of Spencerport. He then beat Class B champ, Gary Craig of Perry, 9-0, for his Section 5 crown.

Runners up in the Section final, all champions in their own class, from the Finger Lakes were 115 pound Rich Johnson of Victor, 138 pound Harold Smith of Dundee, Ahonen of Victor, Ron Warner of Victor at 215 unlimited Steve Coats of Canandaigua.

Johnson was pinned by Steve Silver of Spencerport, the defending 112 pound champ; Smith was decisioned, 15-1, by Spencerport's Tom Eastwood, Warner was nipped, 9-8 by Dan Murphy of Greece - Olympia and Coats was pinned in 3:03 minutes by Warsaw's John Hackmer.

Spencerport wound up with the team title in Class A, beating out Canandaigua in second and third place finishers, while Victor won the Class B crown.

In other Class A action, Saturday, Canandaigua's Dennis Jones decisioned Frank Martello of Greece-Athena, 8-1, in the semi-finals but lost to Jim Polsinelli of Eastridge, 4-0, at 126 pounds.

While Bruce Hadsell won the 132 pound class, Rick Pedersen of Midlakes was beaten by Kundin, 3-1 in the semi-finals and then bowed to Gringer, 4-2, in the consolation round.

At 167 pounds, Al Keller of Midlakes lost an 18-1 decision to Greg Clark of Pittsford in the semi-finals and then dropped a 7-5 decision to Carl Romesser of Attica in the consolations.

Bill Bartosch of Canandaigua dropped a 6-4 decision to Rich McPhee of East Rochester in the semi-finals of the 177 pound class and then was pinned by Mike Macaluso of Gates Chili in the consolation round.

Clay Barnard, Hilton 155 pounder, won the John Ordway outstanding wrestler award for Section 5.
