The hard-charging Forte beat Grillo, 7-0, in the finals of the Geneseo Tournament. He didn't dominate this match but broke a 3-3 tie early in the third period by rolling Grillo to his back.

East Rochester senior Keith Pittinaro and Greece Olympia senior Don Carlo-Clauss still were in contention to win their weight classes and earn back-to-back trips to the states. Their matches were not completed by press time for this editon.

Carlo-Clauss, a state champion last season, faced Sean McIntosh of Wavland-Cohocton in the 140pound final.

In the semifinals, Carlo-Clauss avoided an upset at the hands of Batavia Notre Dame's Chris Sabato. Carlo-Clauss was on his back at one point, but went on to win, 16-14.

Pittinaro, the Section V Class C champion, pinned two opponents on his way to the 130 finals, where he faced Geneseo's Bill Rossborough. Avon's Rob Hatch, who qualified

for the 1997 state tournament, was dropped into the consolation bracket after losing, 8-7 to Brockport's

Mahnseah Boley in the semifinals.

Rush-Henrietta junior Shamir Rhodes and Spencerport senior lason Brongo squared off in the 135pound final, Rhodes edged Brongo, 6-4 in overtime in last week's Section V Class A final.

Franklin junior Michael Brown pinned Wayne senior I.C. Montroy with 33 seconds left in a 171-pound semifinal, while trailing 13-0.

Brown led 9-7 when Montroy hit a reversal for two points and picked up another pair on back points.

Brown earned a point with an escape, but was taken down again by Montroy

In an instant, Brown was able to flip the two-time Class B sectional champion on to his back and squeeze his way to the pin.
