

# Comets Win East-West Feature

Rush-Henrietta rallied from a 24-8 deficit with victories in the last four weight classes to defeat Spencerport, 25-24, in the championship match of the 6th annual Monroe County East-West Day wrestling tournament last night at RIT.

In the other interdivisional matches, East Rochester trimmed Churchville-Chili, 36-15; Pittsford edged Irondequoit, 24-22; Webster defeated Hilton, 24-17; Greece Athena and Penfield battled to a 27-27 draw; Eastridge won, 31-18, over Gates-Chili; Greece Arcadia ripped Brighton, 45-18; Brockport scored a 30-20 win over Fairport and Greece Olympia decisioned Honeyoye Falls-Lima, 37-18.

The first place teams in the County East and West wrestled each other as did the runners-up, third place teams, etc. The County tournament to determine Section representatives will be held next Saturday at RIT.

The Comets' victory avenged last year's 26-15 loss for the county championship. Spencerport was bidding to become the first team ever to win three straight times.

Spencerport led, 24-21, going
