- Q - Why do you go out for wrestling?
 A - That's a tough question. I like the action.
 Q - Who has your toughest opponent been in the 4 years you've been on wrestling?
 A - It would have to be John Olesnik. He beat me by 2 points.
 Q - Which match do you consider to be your best victory?
 A - My 16 second pin against Hilton. No, wait a minute... it was 14 seconds. 16 was the old school record.
 Q - Who set the old record?
 A - Ron Rauscher, 3 years ago.
 Q - What's the hardest thing about wrestling?
 A - Practice
 Q - You mean practice is harder than cutting weight?
 A - Practice you're cutting weight in anyway. Cutting weight is what you practice for.
 Q - What would you say was the best dual meet you've been in?
 A - When we beat Irondequoit last year.
 Q - Are you going to miss wrestling after you graduate?
 A - Definitely.
 Q - How should next year's team be?

 Q - What weight are you going in the counties?

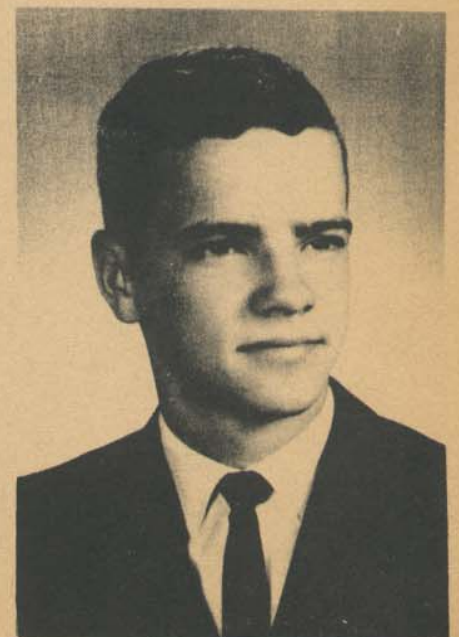
