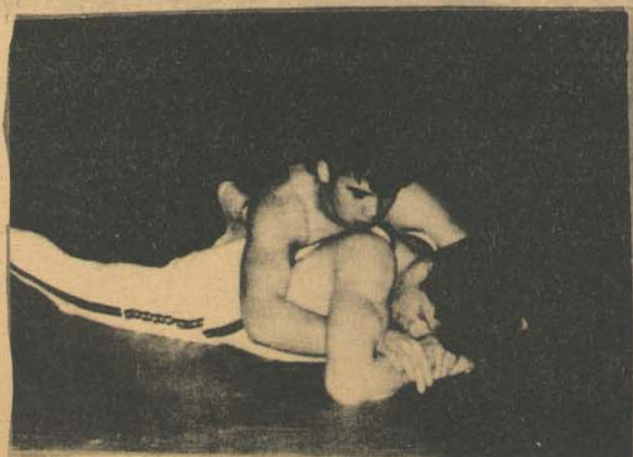
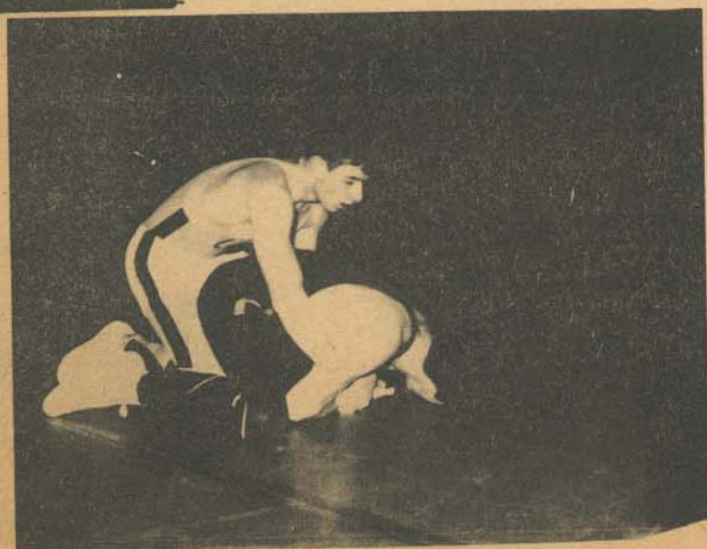

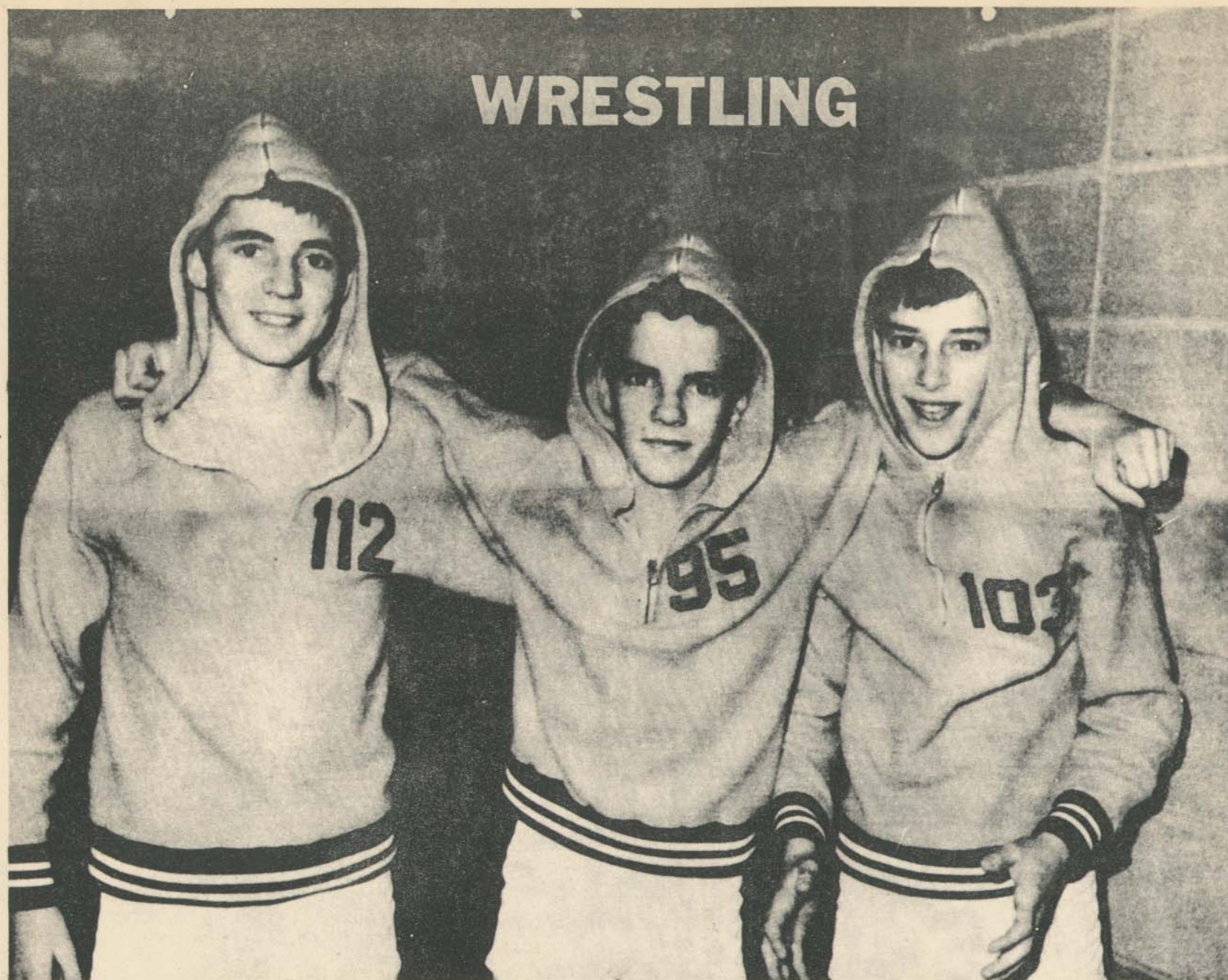
## SCALZO DEFEATS MARTIN

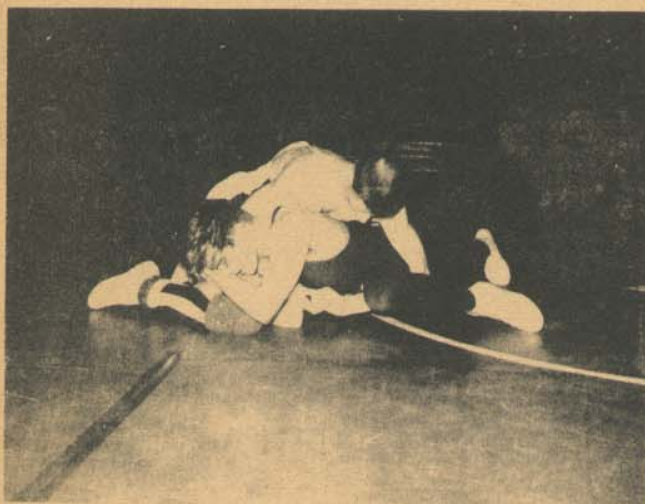
