

Monroe vs. Delhi

Tonight's match shapes up as the first big match of the young season in Region III. Both teams have identical 3-0 records and tonight is the first league match for the Tribunes and the Broncos.

Last year the Broncos took a 3-0 record and a 16 match winning streak to Rochester and lost to Monroe 27-18. Monroe went on to a 18-1 season (losing their last match to Morrisville) and a fourth place finish in the Region III Tourney.

In addition to their fine team season last year Monroe crowned their first Region III Champion, Bill Welsh. Delhi finished the season 8-6 last year and placed 7th in the 19 team Regional Tourney.

Monroe will be led by Captain Dave Brown who last year lost 6-3 to Lyle Munn. Their only other returnee is Scott Swanson who lost by a full to Dennis Edwards. Don Pembrige is the lone Bronco back having lost 8-4 last year at Monroe. Delhi is captained this year by Howard Finch.

Monroe is coached by Mike Cronmiller who is beginning his second year as head coach. In a pre-season poll Monroe was ranked 4th. Delhi begins its fourth year under coach Frank Millard and was ranked 8th in the pre-season poll.

Around the Region: Frank Millard, President of the Region III Coaches, announces the Regional Tournament has been switched to Delhi and will be held on February 14 and 15, 1975. Scuttlebutt has it that defending champion Jamestown is again very tough. Morrisville and Alfred are also loaded. The former easily defeated Auburn this week and the latter destroyed Corning after Thanksgiving.

Jim Hauptfleisch, last year's captain at Delhi, is doing extremely well at Oswego and is highly rated in the tough SUNY conference. His 260 pound frame has been topped by a brush cut so he does stand out on the large campus!

Former Delhi Coach Bob Jones will be the head official at this year's Regional Tourney. Former Delhi greets Mike Waller, Bob Waller, Dale Graham, and Roger Ingalls are finished with their careers so now only Hauptfleisch is competing at the four year level.
