# Moore, Barbi, DelPapa, Kenny, Couch, Capone, Addante Win Section 5 Shields

Seven Wayne-Finger Lakes Conference wrestlers won Section 5 shields, Saturday, copping two in the Class A competition and five in Class B.

Nick Barbi of Mynderse Academy was the only repeater among area entries while Dick Moore, Geneva heavyweight, completed an undefeated season as he won his first shield.

Moore won one of two Class A shields by Wayne-Finger Lakes conference entries. Tony Addante of Canandaigua won the 112 pound division.

Barbi copped the 145 pound championship and was joined by teammate Rocco DelPapa in the winner's circle. DelPapa won the 154 pound division.

Phelps, in its third season in wrestling, copped its first shields, winning two as Ray Kenny won at 138 pounds and Dick Couch won at 180.

At Webster, where the Class A event was held, Moore finally got

the shield that had eluded him in the past. He failed to make it as a sophomore and last year, when he would have been a strong challenger, he was sidelined with a fractured hand.

He made up for it Saturday as he pinned John Alessi of Pittsford in 4:50 in the semi-final action and then pulled out a 3-2 decision over Leo Fusilli of East High in the finals.

Coach Joe Morrisette of Geneva, found consolation in that Geneva high "would have won the team championship if they had such a thing."

Figuring 10 points for first, seven for second and four points for reaching the semi-finals, Morrisette figured the Panthers for 37 points with Corning Free Academy the closest challenger with 27 points.

The Panthers moved two others into the finals and Morrisette felt that one of them should have been a winner.

Chuck Principio, 103 pound W-FL champion, lost a 3-2 decision to Bob McFarland of Madison, but Morrisette claims that "Chuck had a predicament (worth two points) but he didn't get them."

McFarland was a defending champion and he took the victory with an escape in the final 10 seconds to break a 2-2 tie.

Another finalist from Geneva was Louis Ray, 145 pounder, who was pinned by Roy Washington of Monroe with two seconds remaining in the match (5:58).

One Canandaiguan also lost out in the finals. Bruce Johnson lost a 3-0 decision to John Legnino of East in the 120 pound division.

Genevans beaten in the semi-finals were Larry Principio at 95 pounds, a 5-2 loser to Steve Coleman of Brockport; Pete Teichner at 133 pounds, 8-5 loser to Joe DeFelice of East Rochester; Ted Glass at 138 pounds, pinned by Jim Consaul of East Rochester in 1:41, and Dave VanGordon at 154 pounds, 7-5 loser to Ken Brooks of Gates-Chili.

At Attica, scene of the Class B tournament, Barbi kept his unbeaten record (he was held to one tie) as he pinned Gary Rose of Churchville-Chili in 37 seconds in a semi-final bout and then decided Wayne Hughes of Avoca, 6-0, in the finals.

Although no such award was given, Barbi was generally con-

sidered to be one of the tournament's two outstanding wrestlers. Tom Weber of Attica, 112 pound champ, also turned in outstanding performances.

One of the big surprises of the tournament was DelPapa winning the 154 pound title. "He wrestled as I knew he could," commented Coach Abe Meyers of Mynderse.

DelPapa scored an 8-4 decision over Larry Barber of Dansville in the semi-finals and then won a 4-2 decision over Pete Abbott of Canisteo.

Capone, Waterloo's lone winner, decided Jim Brokaw of Dansville, 9-3, in the semi-finals and then won a 5-3 victory over Lou Hawks of Arcade.

Phelps had not had a sectional champion before, but now the Bulldogs have two.

Ray Kenny broke the ice at 138 pounds when he advanced to the finals on a 6-2 decision over Jim Moore of Honeoye, and then beat John Wolcott of Perry, with a pin in 3:47. It was the only pin scored in the finals.

Couch had little trouble in picking up his shield. The transfer from Newark pinned Tim Huff of Churchville-Chili in 53 seconds, a

quickness beaten only by Barbi's 37 second pin, and then won an 8-4 decision over Dale Morris of Haverling.

Waterloo, Mynderse and Wayne Central all advanced one more to the finals.

George Lamson, 112 pound Wayne-Finger Lakes champion from Waterloo, dropped a 5-2 decision to Weber of Attica; heavyweight Bill Pagano of Mynderse lost an 8-4 decision to Don Chalmers of Haverling, and Paul Dutcher of Wayne was beaten by Carl Barron of Alfred-Almond, 8-4.

Other area entries beaten in the semi-finals were Jeff Parkman of Penn Yan at 95 pounds, 5-2 loser to Bruce Kinney of Dansville; Jim Preece of Phelps at 127 pounds, 2-1 victim of Ray Lewis of Honeoye Falls; Dave Jensen of Waterloo, 8-2 loser to Ken Sigas of Honeoye Falls at 133 pounds, and Bill Bason of Dundee, 6-2 loser to Craig Masterson of Livonia at 165 pounds.

Barbi was one of three champions repeating: Weber at 112 and Craig Stone of Arcade at 165 also won second shields.
