The NEW YORK SUPER SIX INTERNATIONAL WRESTLING FESTIVAL is designed to establish an annual major wrestling event in New York State showcasing Freestyle and Greco-Roman wrestling. Wrestlers of all ages, including top collegiate wrestlers from throughout the Northeast and Canada, are invited. Other international teams may be participating. As this is a "festival", it is a celebration of our sport, allowing wrestlers to compete both days under modified festival rules.



. FILA international rules and weight classes are recognized (with USA kids modified rules).

. A maximum of 16 wrestlers will be in each weight class. If there are more than 16 entries in a weight, the class will be split into two separate and independent classes. Each will wrestle to its own champion. This will mean no wrestler will wrestle an exorbitant number of matches in a single day.

. Open Division wrestlers will receive a 2 kilo weight allowance. (Only OPEN Division!)

. Many wrestlers will chose to wrestle both days, therefore match times will be modified:

4 minutes for Open, Junior, Cadet, Schoolboy, and Female Division.

TEAM COMPETITION: Team plaques for the team champions in each of the international divisions will be recognized. The highest finishing wrestler from each team in each weight class will score team points. Points will be awarded as follows:

10 points.....1st 7 points.....2nd 5 points.....3rd 3 points.....4th 2 points.....5th

Only one wrestler per team will score points in any given weight class. If another member or members of the same team placed in a class, those points are not given for the respective placing. To score points, the Club or School MUST be noted on the application.
