TONIGHT'S MATCH

Undefeated Ithaca College is challenged by neighboring Cortland State this evening in the Ben Light Gym.

The Bombers, 12-0 on the year, ranked third in the most recent NCAA Division III poll and fourth in the state, are coming off weekend triumphs at St. Lawrence and Potsdam State. Sophomore Joel Lamson, the squad's top 126-pounder, leads the team in victories (26-5) and ranks second in overall points entering tonight's match. Other top records come from sophomore 142-pounder Ron Gross (24-5), sophomore Tim Habecker (23-5-1) and sophomore Mike Cronmiller (21-2) at 158 lbs. Gross leads the Bombers in falls (9) and total points (90.75).

Cortland is 17th in the nation and ninth in the state according to the pollsters. The Red Dragons' arsenal is led by senior 190-pounder Todd McArdle and senior Matt DeVincenzo at 134 lbs. McArdle was runnerup in the state meet this year and already owns decision victories over the Bombers' Mike Fusilli in the Ithaca Invitational and Cornell Open this season. DeVincenzo wrestled to sixth in the state meet.

Tonight's preliminary matchup at 6 p.m. features Ithaca against Niagara County Community College.

Ithaca faces a key weekend matchup this Saturday when the Bombers travel to take on Division III's top ranked squad, the University of Buffalo.
